EEL's Path to Growth and Visibility


The team managing EEL have embarked on a journey of establishing meaningful connections with academic institutions in order to foster a culture of collaboration and innovation. This journey began by the team enthusiastically reaching out to some Jordanian universities, including the Jordan University of Science and Technology (JUST), the University of Jordan (JU), and the Hashemite University. Within these institutions, EEL was introduced and its resources were presented to relevant audiences. Following these proactive engagements, EEL's portal was integrated into the e-libraries of these universities, marking a significant milestone in the accessibility of its comprehensive resources to students and faculty members.

In addition to the Jordanian universities, EEL's outreach efforts extended to the International Federation of Medical Students' Associations (IFMSA). Following a meeting with relevant

members of this association, all introductory materials were shared with them. The purpose of this effort was to increase the library's visibility.

An informative session was also arranged with the students of the University of Leeds, during which valuable insights on its resources were highlighted, and the e-library was positioned as a tool that will advance their research and practices.

Through these essential efforts, the team managing EEL reaffirm their commitment to spreading public health education and information across the Eastern Mediterranean Region (EMR). They will also continue to engage with various public health hubs and unions, with a specific emphasis on catering to the needs of EEL's target audience, including the field epidemiology training programs (FETPs), public health professionals, field epidemiologist as well as students in the EMR.






BMJ Public Health Journal


Journal of Infection and Public Health
