Objectives

The activity aims to implement and document the Egypt VPD FETP Frontline pilot with a specific focus on measles and rubella surveillance, outbreak investigation, and linking surveillance findings to immunization action.

REGIONS OF WORK

Egypt – selected districts and governorates

BENEFICIARIES

FETP Frontline participants, district and governorate-level surveillance and immunization teams, outbreak response personnel, and other public health stakeholders.

PROJECT PHASES

This project involves phases as following:

1. Cohort Implementation
2. MR-Focused Training
3. Field Application & Mentoring
4. Documentation & Learning
5. Curriculum Refinement

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

EMPHNET, in coordination with CDC and relevant national partners, will implement and complete the Egypt VPD FETP Frontline pilot cohorts, emphasizing measles and rubella surveillance, outbreak investigation, and translation of surveillance findings into immunization action.

The activity will document curriculum adaptations, implementation challenges, resource requirements, and lessons learned. Where feasible, MR content will be aligned with polio and other VPD outbreak investigation approaches to promote cross-program collaboration and operational efficiency.

Expected Outcomes

- Egypt VPD FETP Frontline pilot cohorts successfully implemented and completed.
- Strengthened MR surveillance and outbreak investigation capacity.
- Improved linkage between surveillance findings and immunization action.
- Curriculum adaptations and implementation lessons documented.
- Opportunities for alignment with polio and other VPD approaches identified.
